ACTION ITEMS

NAI REGISTRATION

MOVENTO, (spirotetramat), (Bayer CropScience LP, EPA Reg. No. 264-1050) for control of aphids, mealybugs, psyllids, citrus leafminers and thrips, whiteflies, red scale, phylloxera, peach/walnut and San Jose scale on citrus fruits, small fruit vines, pome fruits, stone fruits, tree nuts, hops, Christmas tree plantations and vegetable crops. Written comments were received from the FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Pesticide Laboratory Section, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratory, FDEP, and FFWCC. The Committee recommended tabling this brand until further ground water advisory label clarification is resolved by the registrant. Subsequent to this decision, DACS coordinated the resolution with the registrant and FDEP by allowing the registrant to revise ground water label advisory language over the next 12 months with EPA. The notations that respective analytical standards, metabolites and magnitude of residue studies were requested by the laboratories and the registrant's agreement to provide this data before December 2008 (due to availability) were accepted by the Committee. **(WH)**

SNU REGISTRATION

CARAMBA FUNGICIDE, (metconazole), (BASF Corporation, EPA Reg. No. 7969-246) to control diseases in grain crops and sugar beets. Written comments were received from the FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Pesticide Laboratory Section, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratory, Bureau of Compliance Monitoring, FDEP, and FFWCC. The Committee recommended tabling this brand until questions regarding setbacks or buffer zones can be addressed. If these questions are resolved, the brand can be registered without recurring as a PREC agenda item. Subsequent to this decision, DACS coordinated the resolution with the registrant and FDEP by allowing the registrant to revise ground water label advisory language over the next 12 months with EPA. **(RM)**
