SLN REGISTRATIONS

MERIT 2F INSECTICIDE, (imidacloprid), (Bayer CropScience LP, EPA Reg. No. 432-1312) to control Asian Citrus Psyllid in citrus. Written comments were received from FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Pesticide Laboratory Section, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratory, Bureau of Compliance Monitoring, FDEP and FWC. The Committee recommended forwarding the package to IFAS for efficacy review along with a requested label clarification by the registrant. **(WH)**

SAVEY 50 DF OVICIDE/MITICIDE, (hexythiazox), (Gowan Company, EPA Reg. No. 10163-250) for reduction of plant back interval from 60 to 30 days to snap beans, cucurbit vegetables or fruiting vegetables for strawberries grown under plastic. Revision request to existing SLN FL-080001. Written comments were received from FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Pesticide Laboratory Section, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratory and the Bureau of Compliance Monitoring. The Committee requested discussions with the registrant for label wording clarification of terminologies and aspects of growing practices. **(WH)**

NAI REGISTRATION

POLYVERSUM, (*Pythium oligandrum* DV 74), (Biopreparaty Co. Ltd., EPA Reg. No. 81606-1) a biological fungicide for use on greenhouse ornamental plants, turf grass on sod farms, and listed food crops. Written comments were received from FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Pesticide Laboratory Section, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratory, Bureau of Compliance Monitoring, and FWC. The Committee recommended tabling this registration until we receive clarification of protective equipment language on the label. **(RM)**

SORBISHIELD 90 BIOCHEMICAL INSECTICIDE/MITICIDE, (sorbitol octanoate), (Natural Forces, LLC, EPA Reg. No. 70950-3-84710) for greenhouse, nursery and field crop use for vegetables, herbs, spices, fruit and nut crops, ornamental landscape trees and shrubs (and other listed crops). Written comments were received from FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Pesticide Laboratory Section, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratory, Bureau of Compliance Monitoring, FDEP and FWC. The Committee recommended tabling this registration action subject to receipt of methodology and standards requested by the Pesticide Lab. **(GT)**
