EUP REGISTRATIONS

SPRINGSTAR TRAP-N-KILL MOSQUITO STRIPS, (bifenthrin), (SpringStar Inc., FL10-EUP-01) for use as a toxicant in Trap-N-Kill Mosquito Traps to evaluate the control of mosquitoes (*Aedes aegypti*) in specified residential areas in the Florida Keys. Written comments were received from the FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Bureau of Agricultural Environmental Laboratories, Bureau of Compliance Monitoring, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratories, Bureau of Entomology and FFWCC. The Committee recommended the issuance of this State EUP. (GT)

SLN REGISTRATIONS

INTREPID 2F, (methoxyfenozide), (Dow AgroSciences LLC, EPA Reg. No. 62719-442, SLN FL-100001), ground application label revision for control of Lepidoptera larvae infesting citrus fruits (Crop Group 10). Written comments were received from the FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Bureau of Agricultural Environmental Laboratories, Bureau of Compliance Monitoring, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratories, FDEP and FFWCC. The Committee recommended acceptance of the label revision for this product. (WH)

SNU REGISTRATIONS

ACRAMITE 50 WS, (bifenazate), (Chemtura Corporation, EPA Reg. No. 400-503) for control of certain mite species on Crop Subgroups 6A and 6B, including succulent beans, shelled soybeans and peas. Written comments were received from the FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Bureau of Agricultural Environmental Laboratories, Bureau of Compliance Monitoring, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratories, FDEP and FFWCC. The Committee recommended conditional registration of this product. (GT)

QUADRIS TOP FUNGICIDE, (azoxystrobin and difenoconazole), (Syngenta Crop Protection, Inc., EPA Reg. No. 100-1313) to control diseases on new crops including citrus, cucurbits, brassicas, and other food crops. Written comments were received from the FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Bureau of Agricultural Environmental Laboratories, Bureau of Compliance Monitoring, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratories, FDEP and FFWCC. The Committee recommended tabling this registration until additional data is reviewed and the label is revised to comply with the EPA comment letter. (RM)

ACTION ITEMS (CONT'D)

RIMON 0.83 EC, (novaluron), (Chemtura Corporation, EPA Reg. No. 66222-35-400) for control of foliage/fruit chewing, sucking, and rasping insects on beans, berries (low growing), bushberries, stone fruits, cucurbit and fruiting vegetables. Written comments were received from the FDACS Scientific Evaluation Section, Bureau of Agricultural Environmental Laboratories, Bureau of Compliance Monitoring, Bureau of Chemical Residue Laboratories, FDEP and FFWCC. The Committee recommended tabling this request until buffer strip and sediment toxicology studies have been reviewed and comments received from the FDEP-Biology Section. (WH)
